SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

1. The Institute should strictly adhere to the course curriculum as prescribed by AICTE.
2. Examination of all the papers should be conducted at the end of each semistar as per AICTE norms. Marksheet issued to the candidates should clearly show the performance in sessional as well as semester examination separately.
3. At least 30 computers should be provide exclusively for PGDEM and PGDBA programme on full time basis.
4. The Institute is allowing Distance education without any approval from AICTE. It should be stopped immediately.
5. The students of 3rd and 4th semister should not be allowed to appear in the examination without attending regular classes.
6. The endowment fund should be created as per the AICTE norms.
7. More no. of journals be subscribed (National & International).
8. Advisory Committee as per the AICTE norms be constituted.
9. Revised AICTE scale of pay be implemented for faculty.
