The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.
 - (c) That it shall be mond-now for the technical institution to maintain a Website providing the pre-critical intermation. The Website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.
 - (d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosures on fulfillment at the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time i.e. 31st August 2009 for the current year.
 - (e) That if Technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/ or misrepresent the information, appropriate action could be miljated including withdrawal of AICTE approval
 - 8 That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabi of the concerned affiliated University and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.
 - 9 That a library shall be established with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) etc as per AICTE norms.
